GROWING BUSINESS AND CULTURE

We know that businesses still need help post-COVID - not just in the city centre but outside it too. We offer world-beating culture from football to arts to heritage to nightlife - and we think that we could do much more to champion Newcastle: exploring better funding for industry, or ways to bring in more tourism, or regeneration. Frances Lasok says: "All my working life I've brought businesses and people together - let's get what we need."

NIGHT SAFETY AND TACKLING CRIME

In 2019 we promised to recruit 20,000 new police officers. We delivered on that commitment last year, with our area now having over 700 additional officers.

LOCAL JOBS FOR LOCAL PEOPLE

For local jobs to go to local people, we need local skills. Nationally, we're delivering 100,000 more apprenticeships every year by the end of the next Parliament. We're fully-funding young people under 21 to be able to start apprenticeships in small and medium businesses, we're bringing civil services jobs to the North East, and we're channelling funding to where it is needed most.
